



WORLD-WIDE OUTREACH

The primary way that the members of Saint Paul Episcopal Church reach out to the world is through Episcopal Relief and Development (ERD). The international arm of the Episcopal Church provides relief and development money around the world. When a disaster strikes (tsunami in the Far East or a hurricane on the Gulf coast of the United States), ERD is there. They also provide money for development projects (e.g., new villages in hurricane-ravaged Honduras, water filtration systems for villages in Africa, etc.) that allow people to become self-sustaining. Saint Paul participates with ERD both as disasters occur and annually during Lent with the ERD "Hope Chest" program.
